DAY 1: AUGUST 22

CAPE TOWN

On arrival in Cape Town, you are met by our "VIP" representative, who will assist you with immigration formalities, help you collect your luggage, and guide you through to the arrivals hall. As you enter the arrivals hall, look for an African Travel Inc. representative, holding a sign with your name on it. You will be assisted to your transfer vehicle and transferred to your hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure where you can relax and enjoy a delicious meal to kick off your stay in Cape Town.

DAY 2: AUGUST 23

CAPE TOWN

This morning meet your private guide in the hotel lobby for your full day excursion to the Cape Peninsula. The day begins with a cable car ride up to the summit of the legendary Table Mountain, where you can enjoy breathtaking views of the city. After descending the mountain, continue along the pristine coastline, discovering the quaint towns along "The Fairest Cape." Hug the cliffs as you snake along legendary Chapman's Peak Drive to the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve. You will have the opportunity to ride the Flying Dutchman funicular to the old lighthouse for awe-inspiring views! After lunch, continue along the coast to the lively



penguin colony at Boulders Beach. Then head back to the city via the naval village of Simon's Town and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure. (BL)

CAPE GRACE

DAY 3: AUGUST 24

CAPE WINELANDS

The Cape Winelands offers breathtaking scenery, warm hospitality, and world class cuisine. This morning, enjoy a time of leisure in the picturesque village of Franschhoek. This afternoon, visit Babylonstoren, one of the oldest Cape Dutch farms, for lunch. The garden is the heart of the farm and is laid out over 8 acres with the Greenhouse tucked away at the rear. Afterwards, visit Haute Cabriere - a winery that produces top-rated Chardonnay and Pino Noir wines. As you visit the cellar during your trip, the guide will explain all their winemaking process and their selection of grapes. Spend time outdoors, enjoying the patio setting, overlooking the mesmerizing Franschhoek Mountains before returning to your hotel. (BLD)

CAPE GRACE

DAY 4: AUGUST 25

CAPE TOWN

Enjoy a leisurely day in Cape Town while staying at the elegant Cape Grace, perfectly positioned on the vibrant V&A Waterfront. Take the day at your own pace—stroll through local markets, explore nearby museums, browse boutique shops, or relax at one of the many charming cafés and

restaurants. For those interested, an optional tour of Robben Island, where Nelson Mandela was imprisoned, offers a powerful glimpse into South Africa's history. Whether soaking up the city's rich culture or simply enjoying the harbor views, today is yours to experience Cape Town your way. (B)

CAPE GRACE

DAY 5: AUGUST 26

CAPE TOWN / KRUGER PRIVATE RESERVE

This morning, you will transfer to the Cape Town International Airport for your flight to Hoedspruit (not included). Upon arrival in Hoedspruit, you will be met and transferred to Thornybush Game Lodge. After checking in and a quick freshen up, meet for high tea and set off on your first thrilling afternoon game drive which takes you into the night to view the more elusive nocturnal species. Return to camp for a sumptuous dinner and a relaxing evening around the fireplace, sharing your days experience with the other guests. (BLD)

THORNYBUSH GAME LODGE

DAY 6: AUGUST 27

KRUGER PRIVATE RESERVE

Your first full day on safari at Thornybush Game Lodge begins with an early morning game drive, setting out just after sunrise when wildlife is most active. Accompanied by skilled guides and trackers, explore the reserve's diverse landscapes in search of the Big Five—lion, leopard, elephant, rhino, and buffalo—along with giraffe, zebra, and a variety of birdlife.



Return to the lodge for a hearty breakfast and time to relax by the pool or indulge in a spa treatment. As the afternoon cools, head out again for a sunset game drive, where golden light bathes the bush and nocturnal animals begin to stir, offering the chance for unforgettable sightings before returning for a fireside dinner under the stars. (BLD)

THORNYBUSH GAME LODGE

DAY 7: AUGUST 28

KRUGER PRIVATE RESERVE

Begin with another thrilling morning game drive, perhaps tracking a pride of lions on the move or catching a glimpse of a leopard lounging in the trees. After breakfast back at the lodge, enjoy a guided bush walk with an expert ranger who will share insights into the smaller wonders of the wild—animal tracks, medicinal plants, and bird calls often missed from the vehicle. Spend the afternoon enjoying the serene poolside setting or a quiet moment on your private deck. Later, embark on your evening game drive, keeping watch for elusive nocturnal species like civets, bush babies, or hyenas before returning for a lantern-lit dinner in the boma. (BLD)

THORNYBUSH GAME LODGE

DAY 8: AUGUST 29

KRUGER PRIVATE RESERVE / VICTORIA FALLS, ZIMBABWE

Take a short bush flight to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport and connect to your flight to Victoria Falls. Upon arrival, you'll be escorted to your luxury accommodations for

a two-night stay. This afternoon, enjoy a sunset cruise on the Zambezi River, where you can spot hippos playing in the water and elephants coming to the riverbank for their last drink before nightfall. (BLD)

DAY 9: AUGUST 30

VICTORIA FALLS

Wake up to breathtaking views of the Zambezi River and enjoy a leisurely breakfast on your private deck, with the possibility of wildlife sightings right from your suite. Then immerse yourself in the majesty of Victoria Falls, one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World on a tour of the falls. Walk along misty rainforest trails, spotting rainbows over the falls. Spend the rest of the day relaxing and enjoying the luxurious facilities and activities at your lodge. (BLD)

DAY 10: AUGUST 31

VICTORIA FALLS / DEPART

Begin the day with a morning activity, such as a sunrise game drive or a scenic river cruise before bidding farewell to Victoria Falls. After breakfast, transfer to Victoria Falls Airport for your flight to Johannesburg. Although you are leaving Africa, you'll return home with unforgettable memories that will last a lifetime. (B)
